#### A. About ICGLR-RTF

The ICGLR-Regional Training Facility<sup>1</sup> (RTF) on Prevention and Suppression of Sexual and Gender Based Violence (Kampala, Uganda) trains and sensitizes professionals from Judicial, Police, Psychosocial, Medical and other sectors who handle cases of Sexual and Gender-Based Violence in the Great Lakes Region (12 Member States).

With the support of GIZ under the framework of the Regional Project on Peace and Security in the Great Lakes Region (GLR) co-funded by the German Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development and the European Union. In partnership with the Dr. Mukwege Foundation<sup>2</sup>, the facility conducted a 2-year project to strengthen its training approach to prevent and respond to Sexual and Gender-Based Violence in ICGLR Member States by adopting a holistic model. The project was piloted in five Member States including Central African Republic, Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC), Rwanda, Uganda and Zambia.

The project achieved the following results:

- 1. An integrated module for the provision of response services to victims of SGBV was developed and piloted in the 5 Member States;
- 2. An M&E project framework was developed to ease assessment of progress made. This was augmented with key assessment tools such as Training evaluation tools;
- 3. 5 Training of Trainers workshops for trainers in the 5 pilot Member States based on the Integrated Model were conducted;
- 4. 4 training workshops for professionals in the 5 Pilot Member States based on the integrated module were conducted:
- 5. The institution's capacity was also strengthened to enhance implementation of her mandate.

- Demonstrated skills and experience in application of M&E systems.
